He has overcome multiple drug problems as well as a major heart defect during his career, and he has written an autobiography, *Walking a Golden Mile*. Matthews was born in Codsall Wood, Staffordshire, England, United Kingdom, before moving with his family to London. Matthews made his ring debut wrestling in carnivals and on the North Pier of Blackpool at the age of fifteen.
